4. Treasurer Report

5. Update from the Board

- Movie Nights have been pushed till February to focus on the Casino night.
- Freeze sales Boxes or freezes have been bought parent support is required in order to get one up and running.

6. Business

- Casino Fundraiser
 - License has been approved.
 - The newly elected board members have been updated with the AGLC
 - Sign up is now live for volunteers and the link has been posted on the Friends of Mitford Facebook page. It will also appear in the Beats and Buzz soon.
 - There are 33 volunteer positions required (23 roles and 10 backups) over the two days.
 - Currently 17 positions have been filled which includes four Casino Angles. If you want to work in a specific role or work with a specific person sign up now.

- Emails have been sent to anyone who previously responded to the volunteer call out request.
- Casino Angles are volunteers who help out organizations during casino nights.
 As the Band concert is on the first night of the Casino fundraiser the Casino Angles were contacted and four individuals have signed up.
- Band teacher to be contacted about moving Band concert.
- The Casino advisory as made several suggestions on how to beef up volunteers these ideas will be discussed with the school.
- Costs associated to the Casino night include:
 - A Casino Adviser, who is required by the AGLC, to make sure everything is done in accordance to law and policy.
 - A Countroom Advisor, who is required by the AGLC.
 (The fees for the above positions are regulated by the AGLC).
 - Food and drinks for the volunteers: there is a budget of \$1175 for meals / food / drinks by AGLC, anything over this amount will come our of our general account.

Except for the overage of food and drinks the payment will be taken out of the profit from the Casino night.

7. Round Table Discussion

• Healthy Hunger is used by Bow Valley and is how they do lunch orders; minus some fees the profits are returned to the school as a fundraiser. Mr. Fultz has previous experience with Healthy Hunger and had a bad experience. Mr. Fultz confirms that Lunch Box also acts as a fundraiser. The school uses Lunch Box because the Admin staff run Lunch Box and find it easy to work with and only requires student leaders to help deliver the food. School would be happy to have the parents take on the hot lunch program.

- The vending machines at Mitford are also a fundraiser for the school and do very well. The school is looking into getting a second machine.
- Playground: Mr. Fultz has spoken to other schools that have had to fundraise for a new playground and found that the most seamless way is to create a subcommittee under the Friends of Mitford Society.
 - The Friends of Mitford would still be focused on the general fundraising.
 - The sub committees only focus would be the playground. This would include research, connection with the Town of Cochrane (as the playground is used by the community), and fundraising for the playground.
 - A third bank account would need to be opened for new sub-committee.
 - There is a three year window for the playground, we need to get started, but is not urgent yet.
 - Mr. Fultz to look into partnership with the town.
- The Playground sub-committee will be put on the agenda after the Casino fundraiser has passed.
- The next Friends of Mitford meeting will be held at 7:00pm on December 3, 2024 at the Mitford School Learning Commons. Note: There is no School Council meeting that night.
