In-School Learning

Mitford School has aligned its start up plans in accordance with guidance from RVS <u>Scenario 1</u>. Our hope is to remain in this scenario for the school year, but we are ready to adjust to other scenarios should that be determined as necessary by Alberta Health Services.

Online Learning

To accommodate families who are not comfortable having their child attend in person schooling, RVS is providing an Online Learning option for the 2020/21 school year. Information regarding RVS online learning is found on the RVS website.

New Mitford School Boundaries

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Beginning in September 2020 Heartland students for grade 6-8 have been designated to attend Mitford School, but with the option to remain at their current school for one more year. In 2021/22 Mitford will add grade 5 to its grade configuration. These changes will bring important growth and sustainability to our school community in a significant way.

School Council Meeting - Trustee Report

Back to School

RVS welcomed over 25,500 students back to school for the 2020/2021 year, approximately 3000 of those in our new RVS Online. It has been a huge undertaking by many dedicated and committed RVS staff to get us to this point so we can open schools as safely as possible, while allowing flexibility for families who choose to engage in learning online for home. Schools have reopened in 'Scenario 1 – Near Normal with Health Measures in Place. The RVS Re-Entry plan outlines the protocols for schools and parents are encourage to read it through and review the information available at www.rockyview.ab.ca/school-re-entry-plan

Outbreak Protocol

Schools, AHS, and Alberta Health will work in collaboration in the unfortunate event that a member of a school community tests positive for COVID-19. All parents of the school will be informed by the school principal if an individual tests positive, and parents of students who may be close contacts of a confirmed case will receive an additional letter from the principal.
